Medications Stocked on Each Watercraft:

ALS: The following is the medication list and minimum requirements that each ALS watercraft in the System is required to carry. The System will follow the Regional Policy for medications:

Adenosine (6mg/2mL)	5 <u>or</u>
Adenosine (6mg/2mL pre-filled syringe)	1 <u>and</u>
Adenosine (12mg/4mL pre-filled syringe)	2
Albuterol inhaler set	3
Amiodarone (50mg/3mL)	3
Aspirin (81 mg chewable)	6
Atropine (1mg/10mL)	4
Dextrose (50%/50mL)	2
Diazepam (10mg/2mL)	1
Diphenhydramine (50mg/1mL)	2
Epinephrine 1:10,000 (1mg/mL)	6
Epinephrine 1:1000 (1mL)	2
Glucagon (1mg vial)	2
Ketorolac (30mg/mL)	2 <u>or</u>
Ketorolac (60mg/1mL)	1
Morphine Sulfate (10mg/1mL)	1
Naloxone HCL (2mg/2mL)	3
Nitro tabs (25 tabs – 1/150)	1
Ondansetron (2mg/1mL)	2
Promethazine (25mg/1mL)	1
Sodium bicarb – infant (4.2%/10mL)	1
Sodium bicarb – adult (8.4%/50mL)	1
Vasopressin (20 units/mL)	2
