DD-17 PNEUMATIC ANTISHOCK GARMENT

1. Indications:
 - 1.1. Spinal shock without evidence of other internal injuries.
 - 1.2. Anaphylactic shock
 - 1.3. Stabilization of:
 - 1.3.1. Pelvic fractures.
 - 1.3.2. Isolated fractures of legs.
 - 1.3.3. Femur fractures.
2. Contraindications:
 - 2.1. Pulmonary edema.
 - 2.2. Bleeding that cannot be controlled.
 - 2.3. Pregnancy:
 - 2.3.1. May use leg compartments.
3. System Protocol:
 - 3.1. System use of the PASG is allowed for stabilizing isolated leg and femur fractures if no other means of immobilization/splinting are not readily available (i.e. multiple victims).
 - 3.2. The use of PASG for other indications as listed above will be at the discretion of medical control. **Medical control must be contacted before PASG is applied in these situations.**
