

Southern Illinois Regional EMS System

I-1 INACTIVE STATUS

1. Request for Inactive Status:
 - 1.1. Prior to the expiration of the current license, an EMT may request to be placed on inactive status. The request shall be made in writing to the EMS MD. The EMS MD will make application to the Department in writing and request the EMT be placed on inactive status.
 - 1.2. The EMT shall state the circumstances requiring inactive status.
 - 1.3. To be eligible for inactive status, the EMT must have all relicensure requirements completed to date of the application.
 - 1.4. The Department will review the request and notify the EMS MD its decision.
 - 1.5. If the request for inactive status is granted, the EMT shall submit their original license to the EMS MD, who will forward it to the Department.
 - 1.6. During inactive status, the EMT shall not function as an EMT at any level.

2. Return to Active Status:
 - 2.1. To return to active status, the EMS MD must make application to the Department in writing.
 - 2.2. The EMS MD shall verify that the EMT has been examined (physically and mentally) and capable to function within the System. The EMT's knowledge and clinical skills must be at the active level for the individual's license.
 - 2.3. The EMT shall complete any refresher training deemed necessary by the EMS MD.
 - 2.4. If the inactive status was based on a temporary disability, the EMS MD shall also verify the disability has ceased.
