I-9 EMT AND PREHOSPITAL RN RECIPROCITY

- An EMT or Pre-hospital RN seeking reciprocity into an EMS System within Region 5 shall meet specific minimum requirements to be accepted:
 - Functioning within a State approved EMS System in Region 5.
 - Letter from the System EMS Medical Director the EMT or PHRN is currently functioning.
 - The EMT or PHRN is in good standing without previous suspension.
 - Documentation of skills proficiency – competencies testing within the last six months at the EMT's current level of licensure.
 - Documentation of field skills within the previous two months:
 - EMT-I:
 - Endotracheal intubation.
 - IV initiation.
 - ILS run.
 - EMT-P and PHRN:
 - Endotracheal intubation.
 - IV initiation.
 - ALS run.
 - Continuing education hours earned are current.
- An EMS System may accept the EMT/PHRN who meet the minimum requirements and waiver System testing or additional skills performance.
- EMS Systems may require additional testing/competencies for System specific skills/protocols not utilized in the EMT's previous System.
- EMTs and PHRN shall meet the System's and/or providers operational requirements for orientation to policies and procedures.
