EE-17 HYPOVOLEMIA WITHOUT EVIDENCE OF TRAUMA

ALS/ILS

Management:

- Patient assessment and initial medical care
- Oxygen NRB to O₂ sat > 94%
 - Assist with BVM if respiratory efforts are inadequate
- Initiate vascular access (2 IV/IO sites preferred)
 - Administer fluids in 200 mL increments to sustain SBP at 90 mm/Hg.
 - Do not delay transport to start IV.
- 1.5. Cardiac monitor
- 1.6. Contact Medical Control
- 1.7. Rapid transport

BLS

Management:

- Patient assessment and initial medical care
- Oxygen NRB to O₂ sat > 94%
 - Assist with BVM if respiratory efforts are inadequate
- Consider ALS intercept
- Rapid transport
