I-1 INACTIVE STATUS

Request for Inactive Status:

- Prior to the expiration of the current license, EMS personnel may request to be placed on inactive status.
- The request shall be made in writing using the approved IDPH form to the EMS MD.
- The EMS MD will approve or deny the application and forward to IDPH.
- The candidate shall state the circumstances requiring inactive status.
- To be eligible for inactive status, the candidate must have all relicensure requirements completed to date of the application.
- IDPH will review the request and notify the EMS MD its decision.
- If the request for inactive status is granted, the candidate shall submit their original license to the EMS MD, who will forward if to IDPH.
- During inactive status, the former EMS provider (candidate) shall not function in EMS activity at any licensed level.

Return to Active Status:

- To return to active status, the candidate must apply using the current IDPH form.
- The EMS MD will approve or deny the application and forward to IDPH.
- The EMS MD shall verify that the candidate has been examined (physically and mentally) and capable to function within the System.
- The candidate's knowledge and clinical skills must be at the active level for the individual's license.
- The EMT shall complete any refresher training deemed necessary by the EMS MD.
- If the inactive status was based on a temporary disability, the EMS MD shall also verify the disability has ceased.
